Demographics at Admission

- 40% Married
- 77% Caucasian
- 58% Female
- Average age = 46
- 71% have some college education
- 52% employed full time
- Median income equal to general population

Gambling Behavior

- ❖ 55% report slot machines as the activity causing the most problems
 - 11% report Black Jack
 - 9% report Video Poker
- ❖ Average gambling debt reported was \$44,222.74
- ❖ Begin gambling at 24 years of age
- ❖ Experience problems at 37 years of age
- ❖ Experience problems for 9 years prior to treatment

Related Issues

- 90% have significant financial issues
- 76% report co-occurring mental health or substance abuse issues
 - 84% depression
 - 67% anxiety
 - 27% suicidal ideation
- 34% have committed illegal acts related to their gambling behavior
 - 71% wrote bad checks
 - 19% committed fraud
 - 15% committed theft
 - 13% committed embezzlement

At Discharge

- ✓ Clients report improvements in:
 - satisfaction with friendships
 - ability to make good decisions
 - ability to care for self
 - self esteem
- ✓ Clients report a reduction in:
 - frequency and strength of urges to gamble
 - gambling behavior
 - money spent on gambling
 - problems caused by gambling
