

CASINO SELF-EXCLUSION

If gambling is causing a problem in your life, the statewide self-exclusion program can be an effective approach to recovery.

You choose to self-exclude for one, five, or ten years. The self-exclusion is IRREVOCABLE during the time period selected.

The Department and the Tribes honor your right to privacy and confidentiality while adhering to the program.

This exclusion is for all of the casinos in the state of Arizona as well as all Harrah's/ Caesars casinos worldwide. It covers all of the Indian gaming facilities and associated services.

- The self-exclusion form must be filled out <u>completely</u>.
- · Your signature must be notarized.
- You must provide a recent (within the last 12 months) color photo (portrait style). Do not use a copy of your driver's license or passport.
- The picture can be sent as a jpg file attached to an e-mail or printed on photo paper from a digital camera, 35mm, or Polaroid.



Along with voluntary selfexclusion, we strongly urge you to take advantage of counseling. The self-exclusion form and a list of Tribal/State-funded treatment providers can be found at www.problemgambling.az.gov
